AIR POLLUTION IN LAHORE SOARES ON MORE THAN 80 TIMES OVER LEVEL **DEEMED ACCEPTABLE**



Air pollution in Lahore soared on Saturday more than 80 times over the level deemed acceptable by the World Health Organisation (WHO), with an official calling it a record high.

For days, Lahore has been enveloped by smog, a mix of fog and pollutants caused by low-grade diesel fumes, smoke from seasonal agricultural burning and winter cooling. The level of deadly PM2.5 pollutants — fine particulate matter in the air that causes the most damage to health — peaked at 1,067, before dropping to around 300 in the morning, with anything above 10 considered unhealthy by the WHO. "We have never reached a level of 1,000," Jahangir Anwar, a senior environmental protection official in Lahore said.
